

Resolution

A Resolution Expressing Concern
Regarding The Construction Of Northern
Route 460 Bypass Around The Town of
Windsor

WHEREAS, The Virginia Department of Transportation in coordination with state and federal agencies is proposing the construction of a new U.S. Route 460 between the Hampton Roads Region and the Richmond-Petersburg Region; and

WHEREAS, The Commonwealth Transportation Board has selected a northern bypass of the Town of Windsor as its preferred route, and;

WHEREAS, The project's scope and purpose of increased safety, evacuation, economic development, and reduced congestion are not achieved along the majority of the corridor, and the adopted route compounds the above mentioned problems where it merges back with the existing route, and;

WHEREAS, The suggested route does not provide a safe evacuation alternative with eight lanes of traffic merging into four lanes on the existing route at Zuni with the potential for dangerous backups, and;

WHEREAS, The adopted route does not provide for direct access to Isle of Wight County's intermodal park, thus forcing the increased truck traffic to utilize the existing route 460 to access the bypass, and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the Council of the Town of Windsor, Virginia expresses its strong opposition to the construction of a new Route 460 bypass to the North of the Town of Windsor.
