Subject: Monthly Summary Report for May 2014

On 5/3/14 at 2000 hours Officer Harris and 1Sgt. Riddle responded to 57 W. Windsor Blvd, in regards to an intoxicated and disorderly individual. Upon arrival it was determined that the suspect had exposed his genitals inside the store and urinated on the floor. Suspect was arrested for Indecent Exposure and Public Intoxication without incident.

On 5/6/14 at approximately 1845 hours Sgt. Jernigan located a suspicious vehicle in front of 104 Georgie D. Tyler Dr. Upon making contact with the occupants Sgt. Jernigan discovered the three males were using marijuana. Contraband was seized and all three suspects were charged with Possession of Marijuana.

On 5/9/14 Sgt. Jernigan appeared before the Grand Jury in Isle of Wight County Circuit Court to present evidence in three investigations. The Grand Jury indicted three defendants on five criminal counts.

On 5/9/14 Sgt. Jernigan responded to 10198 E. Blackwater Rd. to assist the IOWSO with a warrant service. During the execution of the arrest warrant Sgt, Jernigan discovered a small marijuana grow operation inside the residence. The plants were seized and the suspect was charged with Manufacturing Marijuana.

On 5/15/14 at approximately 0137 hours MPO Owens was conducting a check of 45 W. Windsor Blvd when he observed a male subject sleeping inside the vacant building. MPO Owens made contact with the subject who had an outstanding felony warrant for Possession of Cocaine. Suspect was arrested on the warrant and charged with Trespassing.

On 5/17/14 at approximately 1902 hours 1Sgt. Riddle stopped a vehicle for speeding 57 MPH in a 35 MPH zone. Upon making contact with the occupants the odor of marijuana was detected. The driver of the vehicle attempted to eat some of the marijuana and after a brief struggle was taken into custody. Contraband was recovered from the vehicle along with drug paraphernalia. Suspect was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Obstruction of Justice and Reckless Driving by Speed.

On 5/17/14 at approximately 1710 hours MPO Owens observed a suspect trespassing on the property at 19 W. Windsor Blvd. Suspect was arrested without incident and charged with Trespassing.

On 5/17/14 at approximately 2024 hours Officer Harris observed a vehicle operating erratically in 11400 block of Windsor Blvd. Officer Harris stopped the vehicle and determined that driver was intoxicated. Suspect was arrested and charged with Driving under the Influence and Failure to Maintain Lane Control.

On 5/20/14 the Windsor Police Department and the Isle of Wight Sheriff's Office co-hosted the 460 Blitz Kickoff at the Windsor Volunteer Fire Department. Members of the DMV Highway Safety Office and officers from Petersburg PD, Roanoke PD, Prince George PD, Suffolk PD, Southampton SO, Windsor PD, Isle of Wight SO and Virginia State Police were in attendance to prepare for the 460 Blitz and discuss traffic safety initiatives and strategies.

On 5/21/14 1Sgt. Riddle responded to 31 W. Windsor Blvd. for a report of Destruction of Property. Video surveillance showed three juveniles on the property vandalizing the victim businesses property. The three juvenile suspects were identified and admitted to destroying the property. Petitions were obtained for Destruction of Property and Trespassing against all three suspects. Case has been referred to the JDR Court Services Committee for adjudication.

On 5/22/14 at approximately 1405 hours 1Sgt. Riddle and Auxiliary Officer Gutierrez stopped a vehicle for multiple equipment violations at Bank St. and Windsor Blvd. Upon making contact with the driver it was determined that he was wanted out of Chesapeake, VA on a Felony Probation Violation. Suspect was taken into custody on the outstanding warrant. During the subsequent search officers discovered crack cocaine and drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. Suspect was charged with Possession of Cocaine, Possession of Controlled Paraphernalia and the probation violation.

On 5/22/14 at 2145 hours Officer Harris stopped a vehicle for a traffic infraction. Upon making contact with the driver it was determined he was wanted on two outstanding misdemeanor warrants from Campbell CO. Suspect was arrested without incident.

On 5/23/14 from 1700 to 2100 hours Officers Riddle, Harris, Jernigan and Swan participated in the 460 Blitz Traffic Enforcement Campaign. In 4 hours officers issued 27 traffic summonses for offenses ranging from speeding, suspended drivers licenses to safety belt violations. This enforcement effort is part of the National Click it or Ticket Campaign to help increase the use of safety belts nationwide and reduce traffic related fatalities over the Memorial Day Weekend.

On 5/29/14 MPO Owens responded to a dispute call at 108 Martlette St. at approximately 2015 hours. Upon making contact with a disorderly subject it was determined they were highly intoxicated. Suspect was arrested for Public Intoxication without incident.

On 5/31/14 at 0055 hours Officer Swann stopped a speeding vehicle on Route 460. During the investigation into the traffic offense the suspect provided a false name and date of birth in an effort to conceal her identity. Suspect was arrested and charged with Speeding, Driving While License Suspended and Providing False Identification to a Law Enforcement Officer.

On 5/31/14 at approximately 2310 hours Officer Swan stopped a vehicle for speeding on Windsor Blvd. Upon making contact with the occupants of the vehicle Officer Swan detected the odor of marijuana. Upon further investigation drug paraphernalia was seized and a passenger was arrested for an outstanding Felony Probation Violation from the City of Chesapeake.
