Citizen Complaints or Police Department issues that are being addressed:

There were no new citizen complaints brought forward in November.

Our police department is continuing to conduct high visibility, low tolerance traffic enforcement where we targeted specific problem areas within the Town.

The Officer's will be conducting a traffic safety initiative at our large intersection in the middle of Town within the next thirty days. I am putting this information out to the public as a considerable warning that this will be a zero tolerance action.

Auxiliary Program:

The Auxiliary Officers are currently taking the leading role in this year's toy drive. They are still generously donating a great deal of time to this agency and the town in which it serves. Although there is very little I can do to compensate them for their hard work, we were able to get those officers that live here in the county a reduction in the taxes that they paid this year. It is only a small amount for the tremendous dedication and sacrifice that they commit to for us but at least it is something. I ask that when these officers are seen out that we all make it a point to thank them specifically for their donated efforts to the success of this jurisdiction.

Criminal Issues:

Unfortunately with the coming of the holidays comes an increase in larcenies of all types. We are taking extra precautions more so this year than any other, implementing highly visible actions and various changes in the way that we conduct our patrol check techniques. It is already paying off. On 11/25/2011 Detective Jernigan was able to conduct a field contact with an individual acting highly suspicious. We have evidence to suggest that this contact resulted in the thwarting of a burglary that was about to occur. This contact also led to the arrest of the individual who was in possession and operating a vehicle that he had allegedly recently stolen. The new tactics this year have also thus far kept the felonious crimes rate experienced during these months in previous years at a record low.

For council and public information, the string of burglaries last year that was solved by this agency after a great deal of investigation and man hours came to conclusion this past week with guilty verdicts for the suspect involved. I just want to recognize the personnel who assisted me with this investigation for an outstanding job. It is our goal for individuals who commit crimes in our Town to know that we will not stop in our pursuit of them.
