Subject: Monthly Summary Report for August 2014

On 8/2/14 MPO Owens responded to the 24100 block of Deer Path Trail for a report of a disturbance. Upon arrival he came into contact with 2 subjects arguing in the driveway. One subject attempted to assault the other subject and was taken into custody for Public Intoxication without incident.

On 8/8/14 1Sgt. Riddle and Auxiliary Officer Gutierrez were on patrol in the 23100 block of Bream St. and observed a wanted subject in the area. Suspect was arrested on outstanding warrant from Norfolk for Failure to Appear without incident.

On 8/11/14 Officer Swan conducted a traffic stop at 15 W. Windsor Blvd. for speeding. During the course of the stop Officer Swan discovered that the suspect was in possession of a controlled substance (Oxycodone). Suspect was arrested for Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Substance without incident.

On 8/12/14 Sgt. Jernigan met with a subject at the police department who had an outstanding warrant from the City of Suffolk. Suspect turned herself in on the charge of Trespassing.

On 8/14/14 Officer Swan conducted a traffic stop in the 23300 block of N. Court St. Driver of the vehicle was determined to be under the influence of alcohol. Suspect was arrested for DUI and Refusal of a Breath Test.

On 8/19/14 1Sgt. Riddle was on patrol in the 24100 block of Lovers Ln. when he observed a possible rolling domestic dispute. Contact was made with both subjects involved. The male suspect was observed operating a motor vehicle and found to be intoxicated. Suspect was arrested for DUI and Driving on a Revoked License, DUI Related without incident.

On 8/23/14 Officer Swan conducted a traffic stop at 12 E. Windsor Blvd for a traffic violation. Upon making contact with the driver it was determined that he was under the influence of alcohol. Suspect was arrested for DUI without incident.

On 8/29/14 Officer Harris was working a DUI Checkpoint on Route 258 when a vehicle attempted to evade the checkpoint. Officer Harris stopped the vehicle and the driver was found to be operating on a Suspended License and had an outstanding warrant from Henrico County for Failure to Appear. Suspect was arrested without incident.





On 8/30/14 Officer Swan was working a DUI Checkpoint on Route 258 when a vehicle entered the checkpoint. The driver was found to be operating on a Suspended License along with other minor infractions. During an inventory search of the vehicle Officer Swan located a small quantity of Marijuana and drug paraphernalia. Suspect was arrested without incident.

On 8/29/14 all full time employees of the WPD along with several auxiliary officers successfully completed TASER training at WVFD. This training was provided by the Isle of Wight Sheriff's Office. The new TASER's have been purchased and are now deployed in the field with our officers.

On 8/29/14 the Windsor PD and the Isle of Wight Sheriff's Office conducted a DUI Checkpoint at Route 258 and Willie Roberts Rd. This checkpoint was conducted as part of the Checkpoint Strikeforce campaign. During the course of the checkpoint officers and deputies issued 28 summonses for equipment violations and 4 summonses for Driving while Suspended. 1 suspect was arrested for DUI, 1 suspect was arrested on an outstanding warrant and 1 suspect was arrested for Possession of Marijuana.

On 8/30/14 Sgt. Jernigan was on a traffic stop when he was approached by a subject in a vehicle in the 20 block of W. Windsor Blvd. The vehicle had been reported stolen in Carrsville several hours earlier. Sgt. Jernigan took the suspect into custody without incident. The suspect was turned over to the sheriff's office for processing and the vehicle was returned to the owner.

On 8/31/14 Sgt. Jernigan responded to Obici Hospital for a TDO involving a suicidal subject. Sgt. Jernigan transported the subject to the Maryview Hospital Behavioral Center for treatment.
