Subject:

Monthly Summary Report for December 2014

- On 12/4/14 Officer Harris responded to the 10 block of Taylor Ave. for a report of credit card theft. Theft and fraudulent transactions occurred in Suffolk. Victim was advised to contact her bank and credit card companies and cancel her cards. Investigation is inactive at this time.
- On 12/6/14 Officer Harris responded to a reported larceny at Consulate Healthcare. Victim
 advised that her study bible and cash were stolen at the facility. On 12/12/14 Sgt. Jernigan
 received a call that the stolen items were found in the room of an elderly resident and turned
 over to staff. Sgt. Jernigan recovered the property and it was returned to the owner.
- On 12/6/14 MPO Owens responded to an accident at Courthouse Hwy and Twin Ponds Dr.
 Based on the results of the investigation the driver was arrested for DUI without incident.
- On 12/9/14 Officer Harris responded to a sexual assault complaint at Windsor High School.
 Victim advised that she had been sexually assaulted and raped by her father over the past several years. Child Protective Services was notified and responded. Sgt. Jernigan scheduled a forensic interview and physical of the victim at CHKD and the investigation is ongoing.
- On 12/16/14 Sgt. Jernigan was conducting a follow up investigation into the larceny of a firearm from Suffolk. While interviewing a person of interest it was determined that the individual was wanted for Contempt of Court in Winchester, VA. Subject was arrested without incident.
- On 12/22/14 Officer Harris responded to the 24100 blk. of Sarahnell Ln. for a report of Arson.
 Victim advised that an unknown party firebombed his truck overnight. Scene was processed and evidence recovered. Officers recovered video surveillance from a nearby residence. A person of interest has been developed and the investigation is ongoing.
- On 12/22/14 Officer Harris responded to the 20 blk. of Church St. for a report of Child Neglect. A
 small child was found playing in the street by maintenance workers. Guardian was located and
 parents notified. Parents responded and secured the child. Child Protective Services was notified
 and the case was referred for further action.

 Upon making contact with the driver he smelled an odor of alcohol. Suspect failed the field sobriety tests and was arrested for DUI without incident.
- On 12/27/14 Officer Swan conducted a traffic stop for speeding in the 12 blk. of E. Windsor Blvd.
 Upon making contact with the driver he noticed an open container of alcohol and the driver was
 subjected to field sobriety testing. Suspect failed the testing and was arrested for DUI and Open
 Container while Driving.
- On 12/30/14 Sgt. Jernigan began receiving text messages from a resident asking for help. Sgt.
 Jernigan attempted to contact the resident and her family and was unsuccessful. IOW ECC was
 contacted and the phones location was triangulated. Sgt. Jernigan located the resident who was
 highly intoxicated and not in any distress. Subject was arrested for Public Intoxication without
 incident.
