Subject: December 2014 Planning and Zoning Report

Zoning Permits: In December, there were two Zoning Permits. This is down from the seven permits for November 2014 and much lower than the eight such permits in December 2013. The permits were for a commercial addition to a restaurant and a demolition of a farmhouse and its outbuildings.

Violations: There were three new violation cases in December (one less than the four cases in November) and substantially less than the ten in December 2013. The violations were for two inoperative motor vehicles and constructing a shed without the proper permits. More importantly, seven violation cases were resolved, three sign, two inoperative motor vehicles, a junk and trash case and the aforementioned shed permit violation.

Planning Commission Activity: The Planning Commission did not meet in December. However, Staff has been studying the Draft 2014 Comprehensive Plan to determine where changes may have to be made if one of the other options for the U.S. Route 460 Bypass/Improvements is pursued by the State. However, until firmer decisions are made by Virginia, the Plan is in limbo. The Planning Commission's next meeting will be on January 28, 2015.

General: Although the Holiday season is always a time for a slowing down of Planning/Zoning/Codes Compliance activity, this year much "clean-up" of cases occurred. This should make 2015 a better and more productive year.
