Mayor and Town Council Stipend Review

Background

The Town Council was interested in knowing whether the current stipends they were receiving was appropriate and when they had last been adjusted.

Specifics

At their March 28, 2023 work session, the Town Council discussed their stipends. Town staff offered to conduct research on stipends that Mayors and Councils are receiving in similar municipalities in Virginia for their review.

Further discussion occurred at the April 25, 2023 work session, at which town staff was directed to place the item on the May 9, 2023 Town Council agenda for consideration.

The last time that the Mayor's stipend was adjusted was Fiscal Year 2013. The last time that the Council's stipend was adjusted has not yet been determined at the time of this writing, but it was prior to Fiscal Year 2010.

Enclosed is a spreadsheet that includes ten Virginia towns with populations between $2,500\pm$ and 3,000; including Windsor, with a population of 2,746.
