### Press Release

The Windsor Police Department is mourning the loss of K9 Officer Odin. K9 Odin suffered a medical emergency at approximately 0845am on Sunday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 while on duty and was rushed by his handler to the COVE Emergency Veterinary Clinic in Suffolk. K9 Odin underwent an emergency surgery. On Wednesday, February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 K9 Odin succumbed to complications from his surgical procedure.

K9 Odin served with the Windsor Police Department for 3 years and was the first K9 in the department's history. Prior to joining WPD, Odin served with the Newport News Sheriff's Office for 5 years. Odin was a Dutch Shepard that was dual certified in Narcotics Detection and Patrol/Apprehension. During his career with the Windsor Police Department, K9 Odin was responsible for the detection of multiple narcotics seizures, tracking and apprehending multiple suspects not just in Windsor, but many different surrounding jurisdictions.

The Windsor Police Department would like to thank our law enforcement partners for their support this week including the Isle of Wight Sheriff's Office, the U.S. Coast Guard, the Newport News Sheriff's Office and the Virginia Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In addition, we are grateful for the professional and compassionate care provided to Odin by the staff of the COVE Emergency Veterinary Clinic. WPD would also like to thank Spike's K9 Fund for generously covering the cost of the veterinary bills for K9 Odin.
