# Memorandum

**RE:** Revision to the State Holiday Schedule

The Commonwealth of Virginia revised the holiday schedule for State employees, and the Town follows the same schedule. I have enclosed a copy of the revised schedule for Council's information. Jackson-Lee Day was removed which was the Friday preceding the third Monday of January, and Election Day was added which will be the first Tuesday in November. may purchase Optional Group Life Insurance up to an additional four times their salary. Group life insurance will begin the same month as the retirement coverage.

## VI. Holidays and Leave

#### A. Holidays

The following holidays are observed by the Town. Full-time and part-time salaried employees shall be granted time off for these days without charging the time against leave balances:

January 1
3 <sup>rd</sup> Monday of January
3 <sup>rd</sup> Monday of February
Last Monday in May
July 4
1 <sup>st</sup> Monday in September
2 <sup>nd</sup> Monday in October
1 <sup>st</sup> Tuesday in November
November 11
4 <sup>th</sup> Thursday in November
4 <sup>th</sup> Friday in November
December 24
December 25

The Town will generally follow the same schedule as the Commonwealth of Virginia and Isle of Wight County when the Governor declares additional or special holidays. When an employee is required to work on one of these holidays, compensatory time off will be given on an hour for hour basis for the hours worked on the holiday. Holidays falling on Saturday or Sunday shall be taken on the Friday or the Monday respectively as announced by the Town.

### B. Annual Leave

1. Accrual:

Employees shall accrue annual leave on a monthly basis for each completed month of service. The rate at which annual leave is accrued is dependent upon the length of the employee's service with the Town. The accrual schedule is as follows:

Length of Service	<b>Monthly Accrual Rate</b>	Yearly Accrual Rate
0 to 5 years of service 5 to 10 years of service	1 day a month 1.25 days a month	12 days a year 15 days a year
10 to 15 years of service	1.5 days a month	18 days a year
