Spring Cleanup Days - Special Residential Refuse Pick Ups

Background

At their February 7, 2023 meeting, the Town Council voted to use the Refuse Control and Recycling Grant Funds to initiate special residential refuse pick-ups this spring.

Specifics

Due to the transfer station only being open until noon on Saturdays, two dates will be required to cover the town.

The routes have been separated by water billing areas; informational flyers will be included with the March and April water bills.

Those that receive a water bill in March will participate in the pick-up on Saturday, April 1st and those that receive a water bill in April will participate in the Saturday, April 15th pick-up.

These pick-ups are only for residential addresses that are currently serviced by Bay Disposal; businesses, or residences that are served by dumpsters, do not qualify.
