PAVING PROJECT BEGINS IN WINDSOR

Motorists should anticipate minor delays

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY— Crews with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will begin milling and paving operations in the town of Windsor beginning later this week. Motorists should anticipate single-lane closures Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m.

The streets scheduled for paving include:

- Sections of Routes 603, 610, and 636
- Routes 1800 through 1826

This work is anticipated to be completed by the end of spring 2014, weather conditions permitting.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling in the work zones. Temporary signs and/or variable message boards will be in place to alert motorists to the paving operations.
